## Friday, July 15th at 6:30 pm

Friday features a collection of nautical items including two ship's wheel, a brass and wood ships binnacle, and a Durkee Marine Products brass ship's telegraph. Fine art including two paintings by French artist Jules R. Herve (1887-1991), oils by Dimitri Michailov (Russian b1923) and Gerald Marjoram (Irish b1936). Glass and crystal items including Baccarat, Lalique and Waterford. A glass whiskey set by Faberge. A Tiffany & Co. Betjemann's of England burl wood expanding bookrack/bookends and a Cartier travel clock in the form of a large pocket watch. Patio and garden furniture including a fine Cherub figural fountain, a granite bird bath and a granite round top table with a twin bubble form pedestal surrounded by four arched benches with two pedestals supporting each bench. Lighting fixtures including a beautiful gilt bronze and cut crystal 12 light chandelier, attributed to Mel Rykus. Fine jewelry including a pair of 14kt white gold, sapphire, ruby and diamond dangle earrings, a 14kt rose gold and ruby rings and a 14kt yellow gold Bulova Accutron gentleman's wristwatch. A fine collection of Chinese and Japanese bronze vases and sculptures, porcelain vases, covered pots, chargers and plaques. Additionally, sterling silver, Lalique, Baker and French furnishings, and antique garden statuary from the collection of Arthur Roshak, Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan. Additionally, from private collections, an impressive bronze sculpture after Lanceray; antique clocks; 19th century American furniture; a Swiss music box; designer bags and jewelry by Chanel and Judith Leiber; as well as fine jewelry and oriental rugs from antique to modern.

## Sunday, July 17th at Noon

The Sunday session includes over 200 selections of paintings, sculptures and graphics from the 18th/19th c. to contemporary and highlighted by a large Marshall Maynard Fredericks bronze sculpture, "Baboon & Sitting Friend, as well as 2 large oil paintings by Franny Golden. Some of the other notable artists offered include: Sarkis Sarkisian, Peter Max, Alfred-Émile Gaubault, Clarence Holbrook Carter, George Shawe, Pierre Bittar, Henry Ossawa Tanner, Gustave Baumann and many more – also graphics by Victor Vasarely, Pierre Alechinsky, Josef Albers and Lowell Nesbitt. Additionally there is a large collection of art deaccessioned by a Michigan museum featuring Michigan artists. Also featured is a nice selection of Persian rugs in throw to room sizes, fine jewelry, French furniture, two canopy beds, Schonbek, Murano and French chandeliers and a S. Buyers are responsible for satisfying themselves concerning the condition of the property and the matters referred to in the catalog entry. Condition reports, photos and video or digital images are provided as a courtesy and should not be used as a substitute for viewing the items in person. All statements made in the catalog or in the condition report or made orally or in writing elsewhere are statements of opinion and are not to be relied on as statements of fact. Except as set forth in paragraph 18, DuMouchelles and the Consignor assume no risk, liability or responsibility for the authenticity of the authorship of any property identified in this catalog. All property is sold "as is" and neither DuMouchelles nor the Consignor make any warranties or representations of any kind or nature with respect to the property, and no statement in the catalog or made at the sale, or in the bill of sale or invoice or elsewhere shall be deemed an assumption of liability or warranty or representation as to the description, genuineness, attribution, provenance or condition of the property. DuMouchelles and the Consignor make no representations as to whether buyer acquires any reproduction rights in the property.
- 2. Bidding Registration. Bidders attending the auction are required to sign a registration form either in person, fax or online and provide proof of identification. DuMouchelles may require the production of bank or other financial references. Registered bidders agree to be fully liable for all bids, including the liability to timely pay in full for any lot that is the subject of a successful bid submitted by the bidder in accordance with the Conditions of Sale.

- 8. Bidding. DuMouchelles reserves the right to reject a bid from any bidder.
