Friday auction features a wide variety of treasures including an extensive collection of World War I posters; unique pottery by Bennington and Shenandoah; Walt Disney animation cels for the Chevrolet Lumina; rare memorabilia from the 1936 Berlin Olympic games; scale ship's models, ship clocks and barometers; a hand painted carousel horse as well as a 19th century cast iron rocking horse; Remington and Barnes riffles (3), twenty two animal trophy mounts, fine jewelry including a rare, uncirculated late 19th century U.S. \$1 Morgan head sterling silver coin, and almost 2.5cts natural aquamarine drop earrings; furnishings ranging from modern to classical styles; oriental carpets; paintings; prints and firearms.

Saturday, August 20th at 11:00 am

The Saturday auction offers a wide variety of decorative arts and antique furnishings from numerous local, private collectors. The sale opens with gleaming sterling silver hollowware and flatware by Tiffany & Co., Baltimore repousse, Gorham, and International, as well as a 19th century Chinese export mug by Gem Wo. Other highlights include French gilt bronze and bisque figures; Sevres bronze-mounted urn; Louis XVI figural clock; Robert John Thornton and John Gould aquatints; Pablo Picasso tankard and Salvador Dali marble crosses; Pewabic and Mettlach pottery; Baccarat, Lalique, and Waterford crystal. Antique furniture includes a boulle slant-front lady's desk; English campaign desk; and a unique American South cherry sugar chest; an impressive bronze sculpture of Mercury atop a marble pedestal; as well as fine jewelry and oriental rugs from antique to modern.

- By participating in any sale the Consignor, Bidder and Buyer agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 1. Before the Sale. Prospective bidders or their agents should inspect the property before bidding to determine its condition, size and whether or not it has been repaired or restored. Buyers are responsible for satisfying themselves concerning the condition of the property and the matters referred to in the catalog entry. Condition reports, photos and video or digital images are provided as a courtesy and should not be used as a substitute for viewing the items in person. All statements made in the catalog or in the condition report or made orally or in writing elsewhere are statements of opinion and are not to be relied on as statements of fact. Except as set forth in paragraph 18, DuMouchelles and the Consignor assume no risk, liability or responsibility for the authenticity of the authorship of any property identified in this catalog. All property is sold "as is" and neither DuMouchelles nor the Consignor make any warranties or representations of any kind or nature with respect to the property, and no statement in the catalog or made at the sale, or in the bill of sale or invoice or elsewhere shall be deemed an assumption of liability or warranty or representation as to the description, genuineness, attribution, provenance or condition of the property. - 2. Bidding Registration. Bidders attending the auction are required to sign a registration form either in person, fax or online and provide proof of identification. DuMouchelles may require the production of bank or other financial references. Registered bidders agree to be fully liable for all bids, including the liability to timely pay in full for any lot that is the subject of a successful bid submitted by the bidder in accordance with the Conditions of Sale.


